

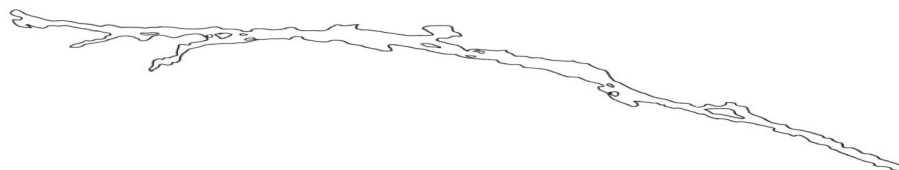

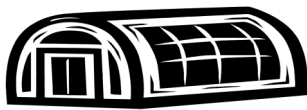

NOTES FROM THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING June 6, 2015

At the meeting, we were disappointed to see that only 15 Directors and members attended.

Several changes to the by-law were made. It was resolved that:

If a member lapses in renewing their membership for a year, they can reinstate their membership **by paying only the current year's dues** without having to pay back the lapsed year's dues as well. This privilege will only be extended once to a member. This is because despite missing a membership payment, we continue to send out the bulletin for the following year, and thus incur significant expenses.

The Directors of Forestry and Environment positions were merged into one position.

The membership category of "life member" was discontinued.

Most of you have received the letter from the Board outlining our problems running this organization with so few participants. We are pleased to welcome Debbie Lanktree as a Director without Portfolio. However, we still have key positions to be filled—namely President, Vice-President, and Director of Membership. SAFETY REPORT—Barry Zettler

Hello everyone:

The OPP were on the lake a few weekends back, checking boater's licences and safety equipment. One thing to watch is that your flashlight in your kit actually works. The batteries often get wet and then it won't work.

We saw a near miss between two pontoon boats colliding. Boaters, please pay attention.

When water skiing or towing a tube, there must be two people in the boat, one to drive, the other to be a spotter.

Please note the new fire pump locations—Wallace's and Zettler's on the north shore and Happy Landing Lodge on the south shore. All pumps are stored near the shoreline or dock, often in a red box marked fire pump for easy accessibility in emergencies. Don't forget to call 911 to report a fire.

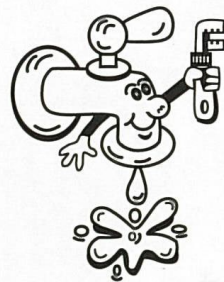

FISHERY REPORT—Larry Hewitt

Unfortunately, no pickerel were reared at the pond this year. It was deemed by the volunteers to be unsuitable due to excess weeds and grass. It is hoped remedial work can be done in the near future.

Our volunteers went to the Wolseley Bay hatchery ponds and assisted with the drawdown of their pond. Unfortunately, they had a weed problem and excessive insect infestation which resulted in no fry being caught which could be stocked this year.

A meeting of fishery volunteers will be organized by myself in the near future.

ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTRY REPORT

SUMMER 2015 Bob Nikolic

Greetings to all Campers!

Annual phosphorus water samples and Secci readings were taken at the beginning of June, however we will not receive the results until next year. In this issue you can see Total Phosphorus and Calcium graphs for our lake. It is important to remember that our goal is to keep the phosphorus average of 6.5 µg per liter and certainly below 8.0 µg/L in any given year. At this level we should never experience a blue-green algae bloom. As far as Calcium is concerned anything below 1.5 mg per liter is detrimental to crayfish, water fleas and other micro-organisms.

At the beginning of July, I was alerted about a possible blue-green algal bloom in Moose Creek and immediately investigated the area. Even though I was convinced that this was not a blue-green bloom, I took the sample and pictures of the occurrence to Sudbury Health Unit. They confirmed that this was not a bloom and decided not to investigate any further. Interestingly, they have changed the policy of condemning an entire water body where the bloom occurs; instead posting only the immediate area of the bloom and not any other part of the water body. In the most unlikely event of blue-green bloom in our lake it is important to be able to recognize it. Included in the bulletin are pictures of what the bloom looks like. If you are concerned, you can contact me and I will respond right away.

On the forestry front, we were advised by VFM that Chartrand Lumber intends to summer cut in the block outside the 1 km winter harvest only zone around Trout Lake. The area to be harvested is north of Shaw Road and east of Band Lake. The access to the area will be from Shaw Road around the 9 km marker. There will be signs posted warning of logging trucks hauling.

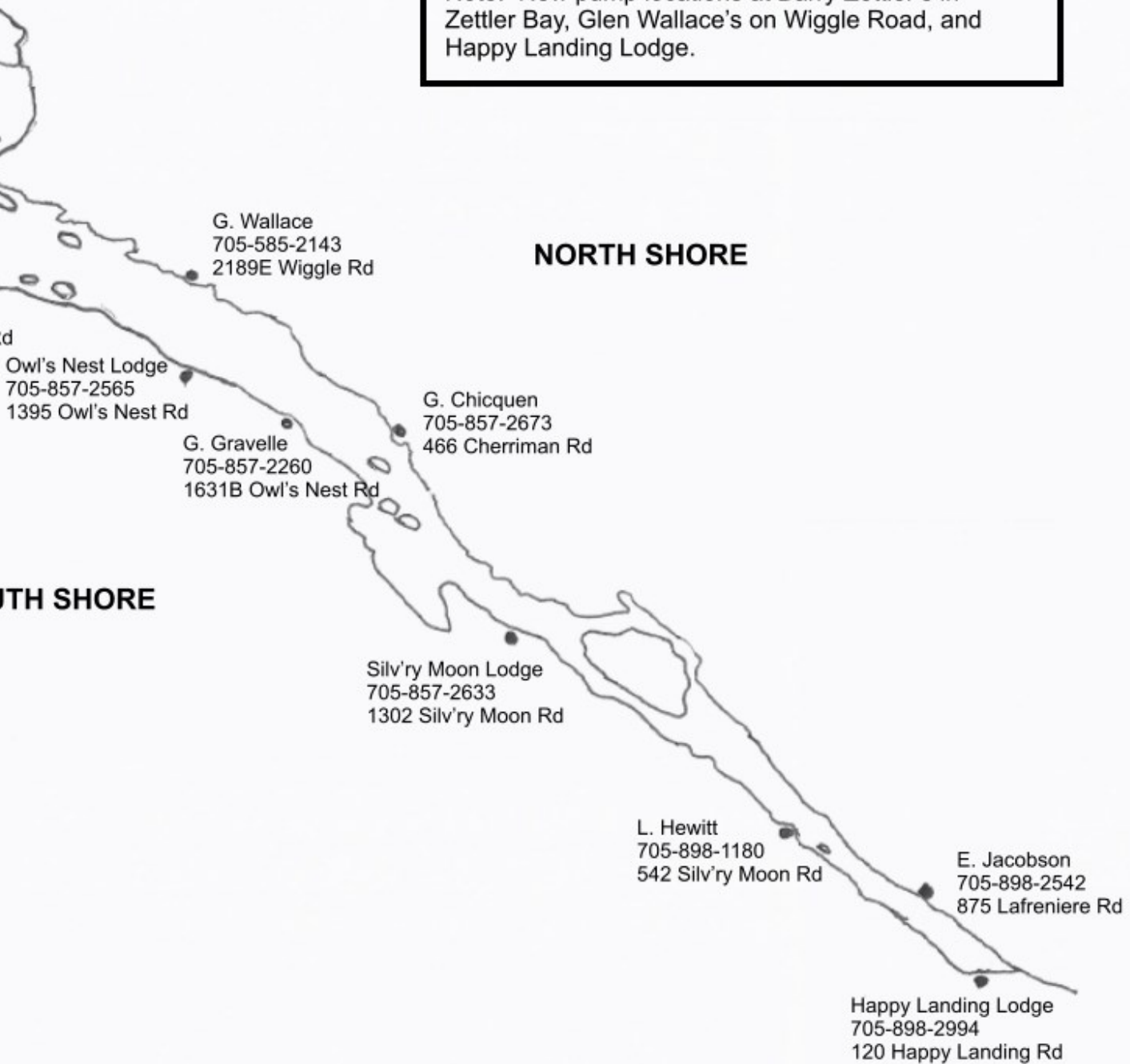

It's Musky Week!! Musky Population Explosion!

It appears from anecdotal data, that the musky population has exploded in Trout Lake. While some fisherman may have caught one or two over a period of many years, some fishermen have caught as many as 10 this season only. Speculation is that we have been doing a great job feeding the musky with pickerel. Musky normally like to eat fish about one third of their size and they don't bother much with bait fish. However, it appears now that they are running out of pickerel and bass, and so can be caught in the bait fish schools, where normally they would not be found. The musky seen so far are long and thin, which also indicates they now have a limited food supply. A population decline may be coming, but it will be too late for the pickerel.

If anyone has any information to add to this subject, please email us. If you actually are catching pickerel, we'd like to know!



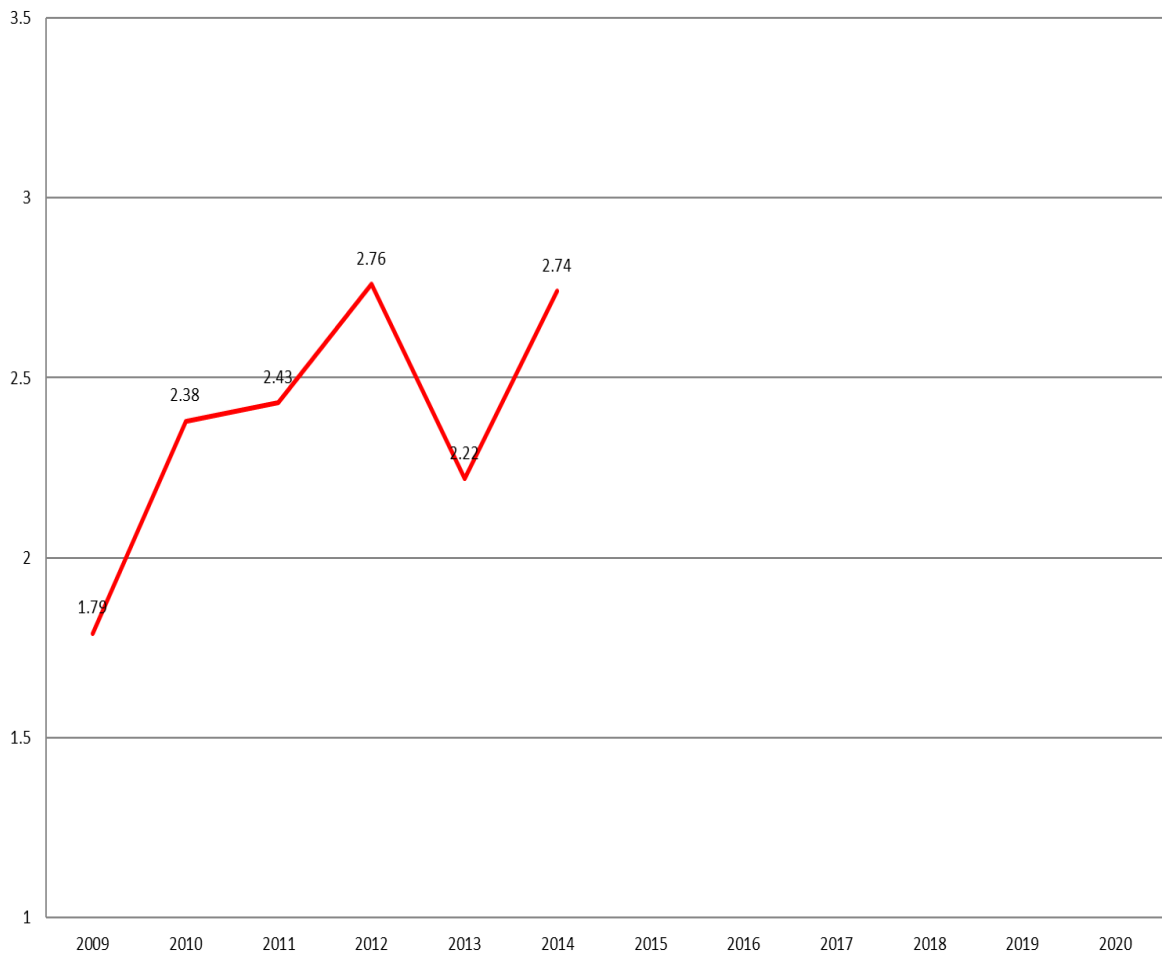

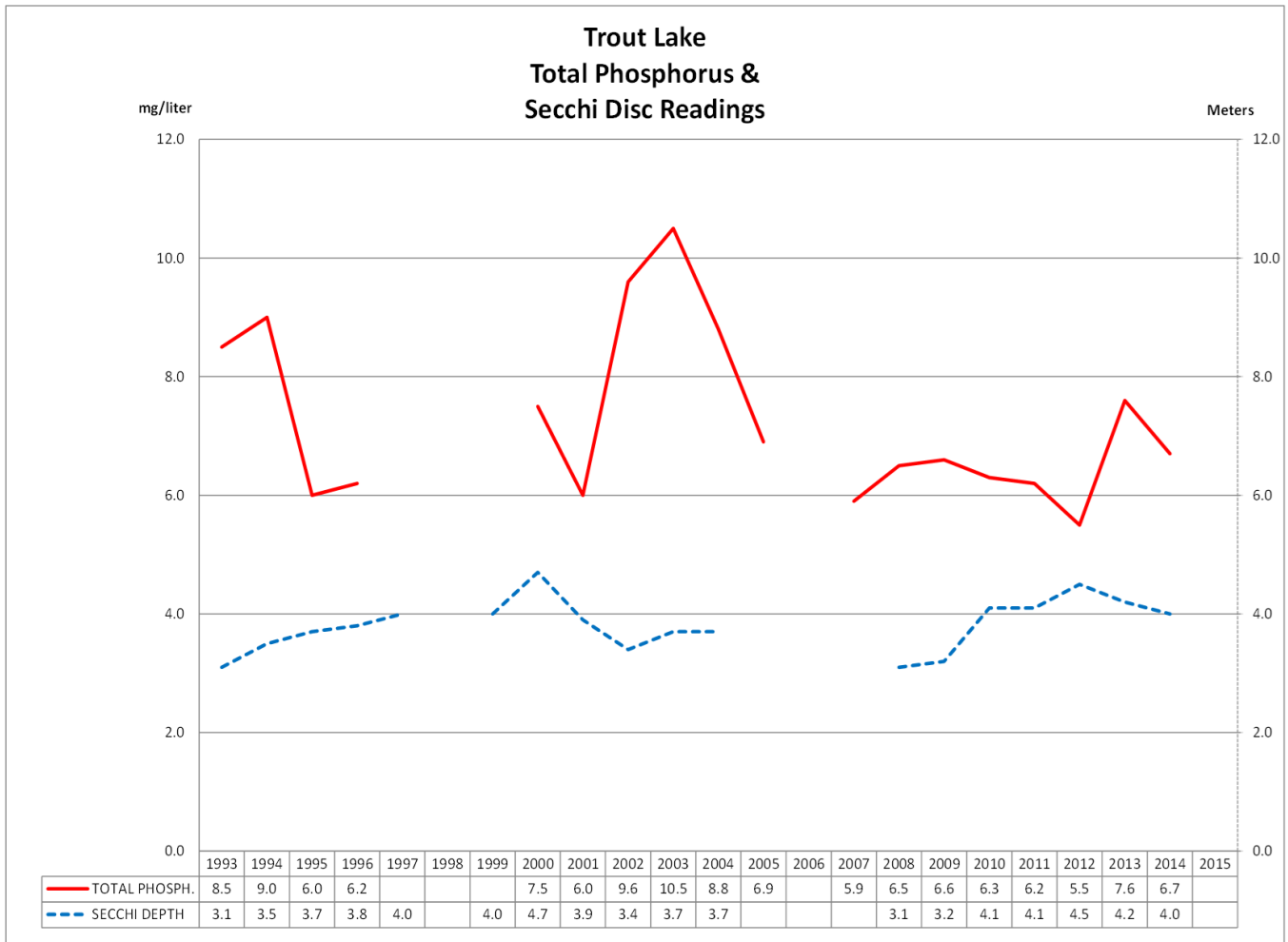

TIPS FOR MUSKY FISHING

- **Avoid** using lures with excessive numbers of hooks. A lure with three trebles has nine hooks that you and the fish will have to eventually deal with. Look for lures with as few hooks as possible. Single hooks are the mainstay of saltwater fishermen whose prey can be 20 times the size and stamina of any freshwater fish. Multiple hooks are not necessary and are the cause of most disasters between the angler and the fish...keep them to a minimum. For example, a Rapala with three sets of treble hooks can be modified by removing the center treble.
- Use your pliers to **flatten the barbs** on your hooks. The concept of barb-less hooks seems to scare people... "Won't I lose more fish?" Not likely. Give it a try on one lure and you will soon realize the benefits of an easy release....not to mention the danger factor to yourself (or others if your casting technique is faulty) is significantly lowered. Just remember, the less time trying to remove hooks increases the likelihood of releasing your big fish unharmed.
- **Bring the right tools!!** Like I pointed out in the beginning, being prepared to catch fish means more than just having the tackle to catch them...you need the tools to release them too! At a minimum have a "**Hook-Out**" hook removal tool. If you're not familiar with what that is just ask for one (get two...they don't float!) at any decent tackle shop...it's only a few bucks. A pair of long nosed pliers will also be suitable...especially as it can be also used to flatten barbs. For those who refuse to flatten barbs a handy item is a quality pair of side cutters or hook cutters (**Knipex** makes a quality product). In some cases it is better to quickly cut the hooks when removal is very difficult.
- A large fish can easily "inhale" a lure deep into its mouth, which will make hook removal difficult and potentially dangerous. Purchase an inexpensive **jaw spreader** to keep the fish's mouth wide open so that you can see what you're doing. These work well for pike as well.
- Another "tool" that can save your hide and that of the fish is a pair of fish handling gloves. These generally have a rubber coating that will give you some protection from sharp teeth and gills....and will also protect the fish's outer coating of slime from being rubbed off. Create a "place" in the boat for these items to have them ready for use.
- One last important item is the **net**. If you are serious about targeting big pike and muskie then spend the \$ to get a decent muskie net... **Beckman** and **Frabill** are two manufacturers of a quality product.

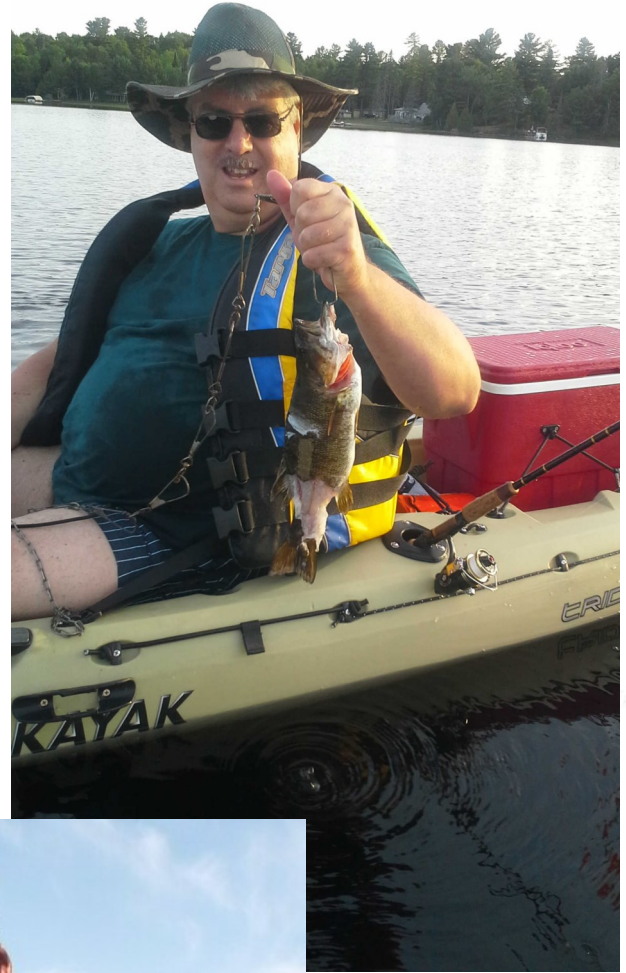
